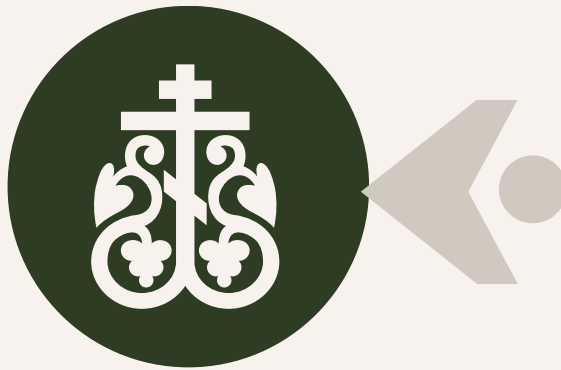

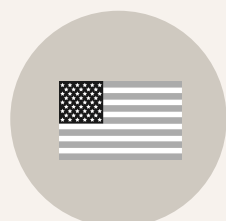

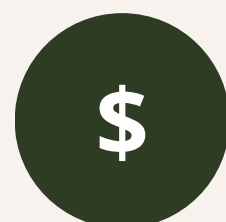
Geographic Eligibility

Donors designate a state to support, & optionally a specific school.

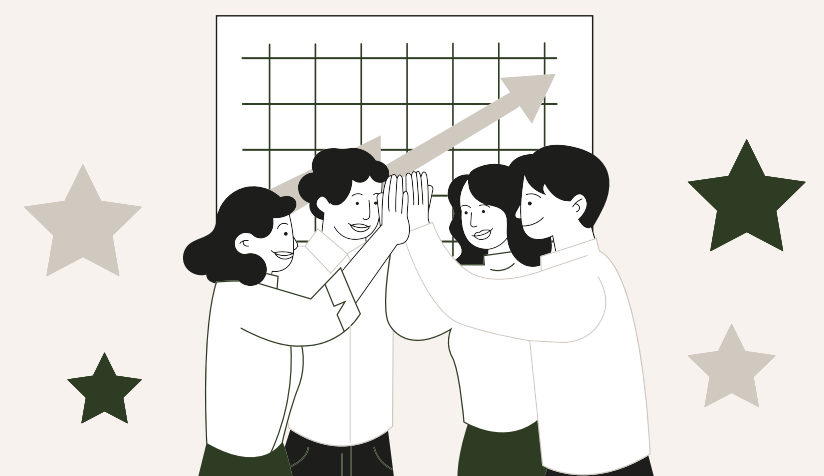

- Family income is less than 3x their area median gross income (83% of US families)

MONTHLY OR ANNUAL

Donations to the St. Basil Scholarship Fund in 2027 and beyond can be made annually, or in smaller amounts month-to-month. Unused credits can roll-over for up to five years.
